## Apprenticeships Traineeships

Apprenticeships and traineeships allow people, particularly those starting out in the workforce, to combine training and employment.

## That means earning money while gaining a nationally-recognised qualification!

While school leavers are the most common group to embark on apprenticeships and traineeships, mature-aged people looking for a career change often choose this path.

According to Australian Vocational Education and Training Statistics – Apprentices and T rainees Annual 2012, the number of apprentices and trainees is increasing, and people are finishing their training earlier.

#### Other benefits include:

- Trainees and apprentices can complete training early to become fully qualified sooner!
- Working as an apprentice or trainee in the Wimmera, allows young
  people to live at home with their family longer, rather than leaving to
  attend university or start a job elsewhere. This usually means saving
  more money or having more money to spend!
- Being paid while completing a training program that is structured it could be on-the-job training, at trade school, or a combination of the two.
- Past experience and existing skills are recognised, which means the course credits could reduce the amount of required training.

More and more students are embarking on school-based apprenticeships. This is done part-time while still completing your secondary education.

From an employers' perspective, apprenticeships and trainees can be beneficial to businesses.

Accredited Training Providers are able to organise the training needs of apprentices and trainees, and will monitor the progress of the apprentice/trainee. But there is also the option of business owners organising the apprenticeship or traineeship – providing more options for training.

Advice to people thinking about an apprenticeship: "try your best in everything you do - you will get more out of it if you show that you are going hard."
